SECTION C: PARADE RULES & GUIDELINES

1. No tossing or throwing of objects (candies, handouts, etc.) from floats or while marching.
2. Vulgar, pornographic, or political materials are strictly prohibited.
3. Floats shall not exceed:
 - a. Height: 12 feet
 - b. Width: 10 feet
 - c. Ground clearance: 12 inches minimum
4. Competing floats will be judged on:
 - a. Originality
 - b. Creativity
 - c. Design
 - d. Workmanship
 - e. Theme Relevance: "Weaving Heritage and Embracing Peace"
5. Float Awards:
 - a. 1st Place- \$5000.00
 - b. 2nd Place- \$2,000.00
 - c. 3rd Place- \$800.00

**In the event of a tie, the 2025 Parade Committee Chair will raffle and draw the name of the winning float.*

6. Judging starts on July 4, 2025, at 8:30am.
7. Parade starts at 10:00 AM, from Quarter Master to Civic Center, Susupe.
8. All participants must arrive before 8:00am. All floats must arrive no later than 7:30 AM. Competition floats must check in no later than 8:30am to be eligible for float competition.
9. Marching groups line up before floats.
10. Mandatory safety briefing: June 27, 2025 at 4:00 PM at Mayor's Office.
11. Only 3-minutes performance at the Reviewing Stand.
12. Float signs must be returned at the end of the parade.
13. Police escort requests due by July 1, 2025 at 4:00 PM.
14. Float winners will be announced at the Liberation Day Festivities, approximately 7:45pm.
